CHARLES TAYLOR BUILT THE ENGINE FOR THE WRIGHT FLYER, THE FIRST AIRPLANE, WHICH MADE ITS INITIAL FLIGHT ON 17 DECEMBER 1903 AT KITTY HAWK, NC. HE SERVICED THIS AND OTHER AIRCRAFT FOR THE WRIGHT BROTHERS AND MAY THUS BE CONSIDERED THE FIRST AIRCRAFT MECHANIC. HE HAS BEEN ENSHRINED IN THE NATIONAL AVIATION HALL OF FAME, DAYTON, OHIO.
