Mme. Piriou was a teacher in Plouray, France. In 1943 and 1944 she sheltered, in her schoolhouse, six shot-down American airmen. Working with the French Resistance, she enabled them to evade capture and return to England. After "D-Day" (6 June 1944) she served with the SAS and OSS in the Maquis until Brittany was liberated.
