Lt. Larson, USMA, '41, was a B-24 pilot in the 90th "Jolly Roger" Bomb Group. He was killed in action on his first combat mission. His aircraft crashed when an engine failed on takeoff from Iron Range, Australia, a narrow strip hacked out of the forest. It was a night takeoff with no runway lights.
