PARK VASSER CHAPMAN

SECOND LIEUTENANT, U.S. ARMY AIR FORCES

Lt. Chapman was a Co-pilot of a B-26 shot down over France in 1944. He was captured by the Gestapo, and held in the notorious Fresnes Prison and Concentration Lager Buchenwald. Transferred to Stalag Luft III in October of 1944, he was on the January 1945 march to Nuremberg, and the 4 April march to Mooseburg, where he was liberated on 29 April 1945.
