Jules Teck enlisted in the Air Force in New York City on October 26, 1940 and was assigned to Mitchell Field, N. Y. After training as an airplane mechanic, he was sent to the Pacific departing the U. S. two days after the Pearl Harbor attack. He served in Australia and New Guinea with the 49th Fighter Group, the 38th Bomb Group, and the 90th Bomb Group (H). He was awarded three service medals and the Distinguished Unit Badge with four Oak Leaf Clusters. He returned to the United States in September 1944 and was discharged on July 20, 1945. He served in the reserves for four years and was the Secretary of the 5th Air Force Foundation for some years thereafter.
