KENNETH AMBROSE WALSH

LIEUTENANT COLONEL, UNITED STATES MARINE CORPS

1916 - 1998

Kenneth Walsh enlisted in the Marine Corps in 1933 and became an enlisted pilot in 1937. He was commissioned in 1942 and deployed to the Far East in VMF-124 flying the new F4U. He was credited with twenty aerial victories at Guadalcanal, Russell Islands, and Munda from February through September 1943. Walsh was awarded the Congressional Medal of Honor by President Roosevelt on February 8, 1944. He finished his war service with twenty-one victories. After the war he served in various Marine Corps assignments until his retirement on February 1, 1962 after twenty-eight years of active duty.
