Marty Martin, a 1943 West Point graduate, flew 364 combat missions in WW II, Korea, and Vietnam. He shot down five enemy aircraft. He commanded the 41st Division in Japan, served as Director of Athletics at the Air Force Academy, and finished his distinguished military career on the Joint Staff. He was highly decorated by the U. S. Air Force and by four foreign governments. His second career was with Hughes Aircraft Company developing the F-15 aircraft. He is survived by his wife, Marion and their six children. A man of conviction, courage and faith, was warm, kind, and generous and a good and loyal friend to many.
