Colonel Embrey, a P-38 pilot in North Africa and England in World War II, was a member of the 82d and the 474th Fighter Group Associations. He destroyed 4 enemy aircraft in the air and 12 on the ground. His awards included the Silver Star, Distinguished Flying Cross, Croix de Guerre, and Legion of Merit. Colonel Embrey was a graduate of the University of Oklahoma and George Washington University. Following service as Chief of Staff of the United States Air Force Academy, he retired in 1969.
